GETTING STARTED _____

1. Have you ever called or texted a friend or family member requesting a response, only to never hear back from them? If so, how did it make you feel?

2. Sometimes when we pray, we don't hear God speak back to us. What do you assume when God seems silent?

DIGGING DEEPER _____

1. Most people view prayer time as a chance to ask God for anything and, in most cases, we expect Him to give us whatever we ask. Why does God seem to answer some prayers and not others?

2. As much as Scripture has to say about what we do before we pray, Jesus also gives us examples of what to do after we have said, "Amen." Why do you think that is?
